ANNUAL REPORT: 2019- 20

It is with immense pleasure I am to present the annual report for the academic year 2019-20. It is a very difficult task to encapsulate in a few words the activities of the school. What follows is a glimpse of great achievements and accomplishments in the session by K.M. Public School – a temple of learning.

AIMS OF THE SCHOOL:

The School was established in 1991 with the objectives of providing good quality modern education, including a strong component of culture, inculcation of values, awareness of the environment and physical education to the children of BHIWANI so that they can excel in today's competitive world. Ever since its origin, it has been trying its best to realize its aim of moulding responsible and duty conscious citizens and has hatched out 16 batches of XII and the 17th batch is appearing in the CBSE Examination this year. During the current academic year, the school is catering to the educational needs of 2147 students.

ACADEMICS:

Education is a continuous process by which a generation is prepared for the future by providing as many opportunities as possible to develop every aspect of personality. K.M. Public School caters to the educational requirements of the students irrespective of caste, creed or religious faith. Through a systematic academic planning, activity oriented lessons, testing and unit wise evaluation with Remedial Classes and Retesting after every unit, the school has left no stone unturned to achieve academic excellence.

In order to help the students of Classes X & XII and to help them to come out with flying colours in their Board Examinations, the school, with the dedicated services of the teachers completes syllabus by December and arranges tutorial teaching till the start of the Board Exams.

RESULTS OF THE BOARD EXAMINATIONS:

In the Board Examinations of 2019, the students of Class XII came out with flying colours. Out of the 165 students appeared, 132 passed out in First Class, 83 in Second Class with 59 Merits. Miss Pratishtha Sharma, Miss Divya, Miss Hiteshi and Miss Aayushi Singal got **Merit Certificate** awarded by CBSE.

189 students of class X appeared in AISSE-2019. Class X had a 100% pass percentage with 79 Merit positions and 136 First classes. **Master Yash Parmar** got **Merit Certificate** awarded by CBSE.

We take immense pride in announcing that many students of the school have been selected in various prestigious and renowned colleges for under graduate programmes.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

CELEBRATIONS:

As per practice, every year different National and Religious celebrations like Saraswati Poojan, Independence Day, Republic Day, Geeta Jayanti, Janmashtami, Teacher's Day, Children's Day and Seth KiroriMal Jayanti are observed and celebrated with due importance at the school.

NCC:

Our school has two Troops of both boys and girls under 11Haryana NCC Battalion under the guidance of NCC Officer Mrs. Suman Panwar with 100 cadets. Every year the cadets participate in the Republic Day Parade and Independence Day parade at Bhim Stadium Bhiwani. **Cadet Tanya** of the school won the **Best Cadet Award** this year. Seven times the school has been awarded the BEST CADET AWARD. Three Cadets of the school attended National Level Camp (NIC) during this session.

SCOUTS AND GUIDES:

A Unit of The Bharat Scouts and Guides functions efficiently under the leadership of Scout Master Mr. Harish Sharma and Guide Captain Mrs. Krishna Sharma. I feel immense pleasure in announcing that the school has been selected for the **Prime Minister Shield** which will be awarded later on in New Delhi by the **Prime Minister**. I also feel proud to tell you that Five Scouts of our school participated in **21st World Scout Jamboori** held at **Chelmsford, England**. 60 scouts and 4 guides of the school have been awarded **Rashtrapati Award** and 90 scouts and 13 guides of the school have been awarded **Rajya Puruskar** till date. The Guide Captain Mrs. Krishna Sharma has been awarded **Laxmi Mazumdar Award** by the Governor of Haryana during this session. Master Scout Dependder has been selected for **Best Scout Award** to be awarded by Hon'ble Governor of Haryana at Raj Bhawan, Chandigarh.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES:

Art & Music form a very important part in human life. In today's world these are means of spreading fraternity and brotherhood. The school encourages the students by organizing various cultural programmes and by taking part in different cultural activities held in Bhiwani city and outside. To inculcate scientific temper, many Quiz Competitions are also organized in the school. The school also organizes Hindi & English Debate Competitions, Group Discussion, Essay Writing Competitions to develop various skills among the students. Ms. Sneha of the school has been selected for State Level Essay Writing Competitions on the occasion of **National Voter's Day**

PUBLICATIONS FROM THE SCHOOL:

Yearly magazine, "**USHA KIRAN**" is being published to bring out the creative hidden talent of the students.

SCHOOL LIBRARY

Our school has a rich and voluminous library with 10750 valuable books, 20 monthly magazines, all the periodicals and 9 prominent Dailies.

SPORTS AND GAMES

When body and mind joins, energies get channelised into constructive, productive and creative ends and pursuit of goals become an act of worship and joy for the students. Our school has participated in various games under the guidance of Mrs. Sunita Nehra, PTI, Mrs. Aarti PTI, Mr. Kapil Sharma, PTI and Mr. Yashpal, P.T.I held at different levels and our students have excelled in many of them. The achievements in sports are as follows:

- In Boxing, 2 students got Gold Medal in State Level Championship. One student received Silver Medal in Mission Olympic Games. One student got second position in sub junior level championship.
- In Gymnastics, Divya got first position at District Level.
- In Karate, Rohit got First Position at National Level.
- In Cricket, one student participated in State Level Tournament and the team got **Second** position.

FEE CONCESSION:

The school also gives Fee Concession to the students. The children of the staff are given **100% tuition Fee Concession**. Students belonging to the financially weak families (134-A) are also given **Full Fee Concession**. Fatherless students who are also financially weak are given 50% concession on tuition fee. The school also gives fee concession to the **meritorious students**. The students who secure 85% to 89.9% marks in class x are given **Half Fee Concession** and the students securing 90% and above are given **Full Fee Concession**. Students who excel in sports competitions get 50% concession on tuition fee. The school bears an amount of approximately **Rupees Three Lakh Fifty Thousand** per annum for providing this concession.

PARENT -TEACHER GET TOGETHER

This is a regular feature of the school when the parents are given an opportunity to meet with the teachers regarding the progress of their wards. Remedial measures are recommended by the teachers based on the individual needs of the students. Constructive suggestions by parents are welcomed, encouraged and appreciated.
